





- utilitarianism:

positive conscious experiences must be maximized and suffering must be minimized.

- diversity:

a diverse set of positive experiences is better than many repetitions of the same positive experience, even if the latter has been identified as the most positive experience possible.

- autonomy:

conscious entities/societies must have the freedom to pursue their own goals unless this conflicts with an overriding principle.

- legacy:

compatibility with scenarios that most humans « today » would view as happy, incompatibility with scenarios that most humans « today » would view as terrible.

POSSIBLE FUTURES

Ann Grim is a cross-disciplinary artist with a futuristic vision.

She grew up between Buenos Aires, Paris, Cape Town, Montevideo and London and continues to evolve internationally with exhibitions in Paris, Miami, Hong Kong, Venice, Oaxaca...

Between dreams and reality, she explores the possibility of different futures and the scenarios of eternal life, evolution of human kind, and space migration.

She expresses the intricacy of social, urban and cultural issues such as reproduction, survival of the fittest and the fabric of new human interactions.

From the rise of the waters on Earth to life on Columba X in 3047, what could be the evolution of human kind? (levels of consciousness, singularity and biological singularity...) its environement? its ways to interact? ...?

Cartography of submerged planets / sharks / physiological evolution of the livings are three recurrent visual themes.

Her artworks range from paintings, to sculptures, installations, films but also, and more recently, performances and virtual reality experiences.




